Drumm Farm Center for Children is a special place children and young adults can call home.

HOME Program:

Drumm Farm Center for Children is a unique organization offering on-site housing for families who provide foster care for youth from infant to 18 years of age. The families who live on campus are foster families licensed through the state of Missouri. With Drumm's support, these families are able to offer a safe and stable home environment, disrupting the cycle of frequent moves that many children in foster care experience. Parents work with a team of professionals to help each child achieve permanency.

COMPASS Program:

Finding direction is a challenge for many young adults, but for those who have aged out of foster care or are homeless, this can be especially daunting. Drumm Farm Center for Children's COMPASS program offers housing and a network of support to help these young adults through this transition. By providing instruction, life-skill development and supervision, the staff at Drumm helps young adults learn tools for living successful, independent lives while building and maintaining healthy relationships.

Street Outreach Program:

Drumm Farm provides trauma-informed, culturally competent support services to youth and young adults struggling with maintaining stable housing across eastern Jackson County. Drumm employs a case worker and therapist who will provide outreach in local schools, community agencies, libraries, and other community locations to conveniently offer youth an array of services and resources that will provide them with a path to securing basic needs, gaining housing stability, achieving educational and employment success, and preparing to transition to healthy, sustainable adulthood. Drumm is working in partnership with Synergy Services and reStart, Inc. to ensure youth across Jackson County have access to these services.

Drumm Farm Market Program:

The tradition of using the most of Drumm's natural resources to teach life skills to the children and youth it serves is very much alive today. Drumm staff, children, and youth plant and harvest a 4-acre garden, care for small livestock and operate a Farm Market. Children and youth on campus participate in the farm operations, giving them an opportunity to connect with the environment and learn valuable life skills. The public is invited to shop at the Drumm Farm Market to help teach these valuable life skills.


Counseling Services:

Drumm Farm clinical services provide children in foster care and youth overcoming homelessness significant improvements in emotional health and daily life functioning, reduction in high risk behaviors, and stability needed to become successful, independent adults. Mitigating the long-term impacts of foster care and homelessness will prepare youth to be productive citizens and will stop the cycle of abuse, neglect, and harm. Drumm Farm uses an array of evidence-based practices to meet the needs of children and youth that are recognized by national organizations such as The National Council of Behavioral Health, Journal of Child and Adolescent Counseling (JCAC), Division of American Counseling Association (ACA), and Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Mental Health.


Educational Support Services:

The Educational Support Program at Drumm Farm Center for Children is for all school age students living on campus. Educational Support services include assessment of academic skills, tutoring and intervention instruction, and online educational programs. Services are designed specifically and strategically to help students with their current academic needs and are provided by certificated teachers.


In 2021, Drumm Farm Center for Children served 190 children, youth, and young adults.
